World traveler Virgil Rochester still calls Connie Maxwell “home”

Virgil Rochester arrived at Connie Maxwell Children’s Home in August 1938, just shy of his twelfth birthday. The youngest of 10 children had lost

“Virgil is one of the most successful alumni we have. He negotiated defense contracts for Apollo 12 and worked with legal legend J.D. Long in Washington, D.C. His experience is incredible,” says Nicholson.

In retirement Virgil embraced a new career in avocado farming. After purchasing land in California in the mid-1960’s, the family planted the grove by hand in 1977. Today, Virgil and his family continue to harvest avocados at their Turtle Rock Ranch, although he physically stopped picking the fruit at age 76. His family recognizes Connie Maxwell’s impact on many aspects of their lives, including the avocado business.

“Connie Maxwell was the impetus of my father’s entire adult future. The role it played in our family is immeasurable. Connie Maxwell taught the lessons of hard work, humility, love of self and of God, and my father passed on those same lessons to us,” says Vaquera.

“Our visit made clear that the number one priority in Virgil’s life was his family, and that love was prominent throughout the entire family. I couldn’t help but think of the influence Connie Maxwell had on that aspect of his life, the one thing he didn’t have growing up,” says Taylor.

Connie Maxwell has remained a part of Virgil’s life as he brought his family there for visits over the years, including his most recent for a 1990 reunion. He is also an ongoing supporter of his childhood “home.” One of the main reasons Taylor and Nicholson visited Virgil was to thank him for his support, but the experience impacted Taylor in

other profound ways.

“The first thing Virgil said was that Connie Maxwell was the best place in the whole world and that it shaped everything about him. He talked about his spiritual life, being taught the value of an education and a work ethic. He also said Connie Maxwell taught him to learn to love himself and others. That’s significant, because so many children come to Connie Maxwell having never really seen what love looks like because they haven’t experienced it themselves,” says Taylor.

According to Nicholson, Virgil’s life story should be told to encourage others. “There are so many children that are broken, abused, or have nowhere to go, and when they get to hear about people who have made such an impact in our world, it gives them hope,” he says.

For his part, Virgil continues to love Connie Maxwell and the lifelong friendships he made there. “The best four years of my life were spent at Connie Maxwell. To me, it feels like home,” he says.

both parents by the age of six and had lived with various family members. When he arrived at Greenwood Cottage Number One, his new life began.

“I loved Connie Maxwell, and Ms. Josie Harden was the best house mother. The greatest days of my life were spent there,” says Virgil, now 93-years-old and living in California.

“My father’s new home at Connie Maxwell changed the entire trajectory of his path. It provided a stable environment filled with acceptance, security, happiness, spiritual guidance, discipline, and love,” says daughter Phyllis Vaquera.

President William D. “Danny” Nicholson II and Vice President for Advancement Eric Taylor visited with Virgil and some of his family members at his home in the summer of 2018. Reminiscing about his years in Greenwood, Virgil shared vivid memories including arriving to work every morning at 4 a.m. to the Connie Maxwell dairy.

“He said that milking cows early in the morning as a child taught him a principle that followed his whole life – ‘you had to take care of the cows twice as much as the time it took to milk them.’ Throughout his successful life, he took more time for preparation than most people and that one principle contributed to his success,” Nicholson says.

After Virgil graduated from Connie Maxwell in 1942, he went to Furman College. At the end of his freshman year, he enlisted in the Navy and served overseas during World War II. His insatiable work ethic led him to keep several jobs while in school, including the midnight shift at the Dunean Mills. In 1946 Virgil married Annie Laurie Foster, and two years later he enrolled in law school at the University of South Carolina. The couple went on to have four children and moved many times throughout the United States and abroad during his 30-year military career. Virgil’s service also included the reserves and the United States Air Force, as well as both the Korean and Vietnam Wars.

During his 30-year military career Virgil continued to have exciting opportunities. Through his private law practice he became a law partner with attorney John D. Long who went on to serve as a United States Senator. He was also involved with the space program from its infancy, having opportunities to see all the early astronauts and Apollo moon shots.

Children realize their talents through MUSIC MINISTRY

Twelve-year-old Myesha has a beautiful voice. To help overcome her fear of singing publicly, her vocal teacher reminded her that she was singing for Jesus. At Myesha's first performance six months ago, her teacher says she brought the house down. Myesha is one of 11 Connie Maxwell students currently participating in weekly voice and instrument lessons that have allowed the budding musicians to improve in their technical skills, while growing in countless other ways.

"I have really seen the children grow in this program. Through guitar lessons with Salena, for example, I saw her change in character from thinking she couldn't play the guitar, to growing in confidence, and becoming more outgoing," says Corbin Herron, teacher and minister of music and students at Connie Maxwell Baptist Church.

The music lessons began several years ago, with volunteer Terri Burgin. A classically trained vocalist and pianist, Burgin pursued a formal music education at Lander University as an adult. She and her husband are also former Connie Maxwell resource parents, so volunteering to teach music lessons to students there was a natural progression. She teaches voice and piano to about five individual students at a time, and estimates she's given lessons to about 20 Connie Maxwell children in all.

"I love the kids, they make my day. I love going to Connie Maxwell, being with them, praying for them, and watching them grow. It's what I love, and why I keep doing it," says Burgin.

According to Rev. Miller Murphy, pastor of Connie Maxwell Baptist Church, Burgin has a special connection with the children and is effective in sharing God's love with them.

"For Terri, it's not just teaching, these lessons are her ministry. She'll pick up a child from the cottage, then talks with them while heading to the lesson. One or two children have said they wanted to invite Jesus into their lives through this as well, which we then follow up on outside of the music lesson," says Murphy.

After coming on staff in February 2017, Herron joined Burgin in offering lessons. He and Murphy have worked to expand the ministry, and say the lessons offer new experiences and skills that can address common issues of self-esteem and self-worth in many children at Connie Maxwell.

"When I started taking music lessons as a middle and high schooler, music allowed me to realize that I am worth something to God. Music is a God-given gift, and sharing it with these kids means a lot to me," says Herron.

"So often these kids have been overlooked, so it's special to see them get an opportunity to discover that they can do something. These lessons are also helping young people to develop relationships that lead to trust with individuals. The child agrees to work with the teacher, the teacher shows up for lessons, the child learns the teacher will be there, and will stay even if they make a mistake. This really is about changed lives," Murphy adds.

Music lessons typically last between thirty minutes to an hour and take place in the lower level of Connie Maxwell Baptist Church, where the piano is located. They can also take place in cottages, depending on the instrument and the child's schedule. Lessons are available for the piano, keyboard, flute, violin, guitar, trumpet, and drums. The ministry's instrument wish list includes three-quarter size acoustic guitars, which have a smaller body to better suit children, along with more 88-key keyboards and headphones.

The children usually want to play a certain instrument when they begin taking lessons. While most children have no experience, a few have previously had lessons. Vocal students must be 12 years and older, but children as young as six can begin the instrument lessons.

Herron shared how one girl's musical talent emerged as a result of a technical malfunction. An electric drum set was used for her percussion lessons but, when they weren't working one day, Herron grabbed a bass guitar instead. By the end of that lesson, the young girl could play through a verse and chorus of a song, having learned where the notes were on the neck of the bass.

"It was great to see the smile on her face, realizing that she could do it. Sometimes in music lessons it's like a switch flips and, by the end of a lesson, they are smiling. It's amazing to see how a change in gears can also change their attitude for the day," he says.

"The lessons help the kids set goals, learn about responsibility and commitment, and gives an outlet to express themselves. People will say, 'I've never seen her like this,' or 'I didn't know he could do this.' It's a joy to see these kids realize they have worth, and especially in the eyes of God," Murphy adds.

In addition to instrument or vocal instruction, lessons sometimes allow for opportunities to have personal conversations and, over time, to build relationships.

"I've been able to share my story and music with them during lessons, and it means a lot to connect with them on that level.

Some I can talk to easily, others aren't ready to yet. God is slowly opening doors through music so that I can have those conversations," says Herron.

The music lessons have also allowed Connie Maxwell to partner with Lander University, for the creation of an internship through the school's music department. Lander music graduates Herron and Burgin, worked with the department chair and Scott Smith, Lander's Baptist Collegiate Ministry director, to select music majors who could offer additional lessons to reach more students. Still in the early stages, the program currently sees one intern serving per semester.

"We look for recommended interns that have completed one year of theory classes, have a good moral character, and who are people we know would do a good job. The experience is a witness to the Lander students, and is a ministry to them as well," says Burgin.

Connie Maxwell music students are encouraged to share their skills in church services and annual recitals, and are invited to join in impromptu "jam sessions" that Herron says happen occasionally around campus.

"It boils down to watching kids mature, get excited about life, realize their talents and gifts, and know that it came from them. It's really special to see, you can't put a price tag on that," says Murphy.

From birthday gifts to strawberries, volunteer shows love to Brown Cottage

It's 40 miles, one way, from Louie Henderson's home in Prosperity to Connie Maxwell Children's Home. It's a road he knows well, because he travels it often to show his love for the girls who live on Greenwood campus in the Brown Cottage.

"I enjoy doing it. No one makes me, and don't have to. But I enjoy doing it and I know the girls appreciate it," says Henderson.

Henderson, a member of Pine Ridge Baptist Church, in Whitmire, became familiar with Connie Maxwell because of his pastor. Rev. Kenny Weaver lived in the Brown Cottage at Connie Maxwell for 12 years as a child, and suggested that Pine Ridge Baptist Church consider helping the ministries there. For the last 10 years, the church has 'adopted' the residents of Brown Cottage, which has included providing Christmas presents and a Walmart gift card for each of the girls on their birthday. Henderson estimates the church has blessed 40 different girls through the church's ministry there.

"I do it because I love the girls, and I know all of them. I may not remember their names, but they call me 'Mr. Louie' and every one of them knows my name," he says.

Henderson keeps a list of the girls' names and birthdays and, as their special day approaches, he gets to work. He orders a cake with the girls' names on it from a local grocery store bakery, and asks the bakers to make it

'pretty, like something they would make for their own child.' Henderson wouldn't want the recognition, but admits he pays for the cakes and cards himself.

"There were two graduates in the Brown Cottage last year, so I got them a senior cake with their school colors. I surprised the girls and had a little graduation party for them. Two more will graduate this year," he says.

The impact of both Henderson and Pine Ridge Baptist Church on the lives of the residents of Brown Cottage runs deep. The girls look forward to visiting with Henderson, and regularly send thank you cards to him and to the church.

"Mr. Louie keeps every card we send him. He calls frequently to check on us and always asks about the girls, often times calling them by name. He keeps a list of all of the girls' names, and asks about girls that have been gone now several years. I am so touched by this simple act," says Deborah Erskine who, along with her husband Dennis, have served as Brown Cottage parents for the last 12 years. Deborah recently retired from Connie Maxwell over the summer.

"Mr. Louie and his church were already sponsoring the Brown Cottage when we came to Connie Maxwell. They have given us money to help provide a beach vacation one summer, invited us for cookouts at their church, and have taken us out to eat

several times," adds Erskine.

Each spring, Henderson and his family take the Erskines and the girls from the cottage out to eat, and pays for the meal himself. During strawberry season, he stops by a farm near his home and then heads straight to Connie Maxwell. He says the girls love strawberries, and mentions he's already made three surprise strawberry trips this year alone.

"The farm donates the strawberries, but I give them money to help cover their costs. Recently I brought them strawberries while they were in school, but they knew I'd been there when they saw

the strawberries," Henderson says.

"Our girls – like any teenagers – love getting things, but I think what they love the most about Mr. Louie is that he gets in his car and drives 40 minutes to see them. He engages in their life. It might only be a few minutes, but those few minutes have eternal value. He makes them feel special and, for that alone, makes me know that he is special. I will always be his greatest fan," Erskine admits.

One year, the Brown Cottage surprised Mr. Louie by taking him out for pizza to celebrate his birthday. Erskine says the girls were especially excited to sign a card for him, and then deliver it together to him in person. Once, when Henderson was hospitalized for several months, Erskine took the girls to visit him.

"When I was in the hospital, they brought me a card and a framed picture of Deborah, Dennis, and the girls," Henderson recalls.

"In all our years of working in child care, we've had the great privilege of being supported and prayed for by many wonderful people known as sponsors. They have loved on us and our girls and done wonderful things for us. We have been blessed, and Mr. Louie is one of those blessings. We know he loves us. We feel it in every visit, every phone call, every cake, and strawberry," says Erskine.

For his part, Henderson says he recommends that everyone consider volunteering at Connie Maxwell. "Anyone volunteering there will be well-blessed. God has blessed me for going over there. There's not a one child over there that I wouldn't do anything in the world for," Henderson says.

"Mama" Elizabeth Spell turns 100

Diane and Rachel Stanley met their parents on a hot July day in the mid-1950's. Diane was four and a half and Rachel was two and a half years old, and they had been raised by their birth father in Hampton County. In the face of difficult family situations, Mr. Stanley lovingly placed his five children in Foster Care and with Connie Maxwell Children's Home.

At the same time, H.L. and Elizabeth Spell were living on a farm in Denmark, South Carolina. Unable to have biological children, the couple contacted Connie Maxwell to welcome Foster Care children into their home. From day one, the Spells loved Diane and Rachel as their own, helped maintain relationships with their siblings, and kept in regular contact with their birth family.

The two older Stanley sisters, Kline and Lois, went to live at Connie Maxwell, and older brother Charles stayed at Whitten Village. The children were separated physically yet, Diane points out, "Mama raised us all, and treated each of us like her children."

Mama Spell still vividly remembers the early days with Diane and Rachel. They enjoyed walking around the farm looking at the animals and gathering eggs. She laughed recalling the girls' love of bananas, and how they both received red wagons as gifts one Christmas. The new family forged a very strong bond.

"No one knew they weren't our children as they grew up. I tell all the children that I adopted two, but got five. And I told their father that they were 'yours by birth, but ours by love,'" Elizabeth recalls.

"We had respect for our birth family because Mama taught us how to love them. I love that about her – she taught us values

in life, she taught us about God, and took us to church every Sunday," Diane says.

One of the ways Mama Spell showed her unconditional love was by being present at important times in the Stanley children's lives. Kline held her marriage ceremony at the Spell's home. Diane recalls that when Rachel's husband passed away, Mama Spell, in a wheelchair at that point, gathered Rachel in her lap and held her like a child. Diane says she still gets teary remembering how special she felt seeing Mama Spell arriving at the Stanley family's house the day of her father's funeral, staying just long enough for hugs and to show her support.

"I thank God for all of the ways He has blessed us with Mama and Daddy Spell. Mama taught us about God, she taught us compassion, and was a caregiver. She was at every childhood activity. I can look back and see that the things that they taught us and made us do were for our own good," Diane says.

Elizabeth Spell turned 100 years old on Dec. 18, and celebrated the milestone birthday with friends and family on Dec. 9.

"Because of Mama, our family is very close today and we are all close to Mama. She has loved us all," Diane says.

For her part, Mama Spell, now a great-grandmother, says that enduring love has been the greatest gift of all.

"We have one big family, and I am proud of them. They are my children, and everybody knows it. We have a lot of love in our family," she says.

Wayne Scott James makes a legacy gift to honor brother's memory

It doesn't take long after speaking with Wayne Scott James to feel the love and respect that he had for his younger brother Claude.

"Claude was a very good man, an exemplary citizen who always voted, was never in any trouble of any kind, very dependable, and lived a good life, thanks in part to Connie Maxwell Children's Home," Scott wrote about his brother. "He was loved by all who knew him."

Claude Blakely James passed away unexpectedly from pancreatic cancer on March 17, 2017. When Scott James found out that he would receive more than \$120,000 from his brother's estate, he knew exactly what he wanted to do with the money.

Scott reached out to Vice President for Advancement Eric Taylor to establish the Claude B. James Student Assistance Fund that will provide support each year for children transitioning out of care at Connie Maxwell.

"My main goal is to encourage kids to finish their education after they leave Connie Maxwell, which will certainly make them better prepared for a rewarding future," Scott said.

Claude was the only sibling out of three James children to graduate from college. Claude went on to have a successful career in the Information Technology Department of the University of South Carolina in Columbia.

His journey, however, didn't come easily. Claude never had enough money to attend college full-time and it took him many years to complete his degree.

"I did okay in life and am satisfied with the career path I took, but if I had stayed in college and obtained my degree I could have been President of the organization I worked for," Scott said. "Education is very important in all career fields—now more than ever."

Scott was grateful for his time at Connie Maxwell and believes that it gave him and his brothers a chance for success in life.

"I deeply love Connie Maxwell Children's Home—there's a glow, a warmth, a fuzzy feeling that I get each time I come to campus," said Scott. "Unless you lived here, after the hardships some families have had imposed on them, you really don't have an appreciation for that feeling."

Now Scott looks forward to helping enhance the growth of current and future students that are entering the next chapter of their lives through this new student assistance fund. He also can't wait for the opportunity to tell future recipients more about his brother Claude.

"I'm glad this gift will be used in a way that will assist these children—my brothers and sisters—by helping to put them on an even more meaningful path in their future."

More about the life of Claude B. James...

◆ Born March 20, 1944, in Richland County, SC.

◆ His first years of life were spent with a family of five living in a small house with no indoor plumbing or electricity.

◆ In April 1946, when Claude was two years old, the home caught fire and burned down, destroying everything the family owned. Only one month later, Claude's father died in an automobile accident leaving the family with no income.

◆ Eventually, the family moved to Hartsville, SC, where for several months they lived with an aunt. This became too much for one household.

◆ Throughout all this Claude's mother kept the family in church and while in Hartsville they attended Emanuel Baptist Church.

◆ Rev. Little knew about the family hardships and recommended Connie Maxwell Children's Home. In 1950 the family visited. In 1951, when Claude was 7 years old, he and his two brothers were placed in Eastern Star Cottage (now known as Neb Cline).

◆ In 1959 Claude moved to Columbia with his brother Scott. Claude attended Columbia High School and graduated in 1962.

◆ After high school, Claude worked several different jobs but had his sights set on attending college. He eventually saved enough to enroll at USC as a day student but continued to work part-time.

◆ Claude's education was interrupted in the 1960s because of the mandatory military draft. He volunteered to serve four years in the U.S. Air Force and was stationed in England for part of his tour.

◆ After the Air Force, Claude continued his education, but he never had enough money to go to USC full-time. It took Claude well over 10 years to get his accounting degree.

◆ He was employed in the Information Technology Department at USC where he worked until he retired.

◆ Claude was married for a short while before he joined the U.S. Air Force but he did not have any dependent children.

◆ Claude passed away at 73 years old on March 17, 2017.

Nominations were submitted by Sept. 30, 2018, and reviewed by a panel of three trustees, a Connie Maxwell alumnus, and a retired staff member.

In order to qualify, nominees had to meet certain criteria including: they must be a full-time employee with at least 5 years of service; demonstrate forgiveness to others; make it a priority to live a Godly example and make disciples; serve with excellence and unconditional love; develop and nurture relationships with outside partner individuals and churches; be involved in campus activities beyond daily responsibilities; and be a team player.

During the November 2018 board meeting, Greenwood Campus Administrator Randy McManus was presented as the first recipient of this annual award.

"It thrills my heart that Randy will be the first one to honor my mom and dad and Debra's parents, and be recognized as an example of sacrifice, caring, loving, and giving yourself to people in Jesus' name," Danny said.

Randy's nomination letter described him as a man that often uses words of encouragement and promotes unity and teamwork. In addition, he was described as someone who is always first to volunteer and put in extra hours when needed. Randy often attends summer camp with the children so that he can have more intentional discipleship time with them.

"When you have a good coach, you can be a good athlete," Randy said after accepting his award. "Danny is a great coach, a hard worker, and a great example. I have a hard time disappointing him, so I appreciate that."

In addition to a monetary award paid for by an endowment that was established by the Nicholsons, a plaque and photo will hang outside the President's office all year to celebrate Randy's sacrifice to Connie Maxwell.
